



CSC Scholarship Purpose and Procedures

Mission

Carmichael Soccer Club (CSC) will encourage and promote soccer and the importance of exercise to the youth of our community.

Eligibility

CSC will offer scholarship assistance to qualified families. Interested families are required to complete and submit the Scholarship Request Form prior to the deadline. All qualified families requesting scholarship assistance will receive scholarship assistance. However, prior scholarship recipients are given last priority as described in the Determination of Scholarship section.

Determination of Scholarship

Each year CSC will determine how much money is available for the purpose of CSC scholarships. The deadline for scholarship applications will be the last in-person registration event. No late applications will be accepted. Incomplete applications will not be accepted. The number of first year qualified applicants will be divided into the amount of funds available. Scholarship funds will then be distributed equally among the first year scholarship applicants. Any remaining proceeds will be split equally among returning, qualified scholarship applicants. The difference between the full registration fee and the scholarship amount is the responsibility of the applicant. Families will be asked to complete a specific number of volunteer hours for each child receiving scholarship funds.

Use of Proceeds

Scholarship money can be used toward: CSC and CVYSL registration fees. No refunds are available. Unused scholarship funds will be rolled over to the next season. Scholarship funds may not be applied to uniform expenses.

Deposit

A deposit in the amount of the CVYSL registration fee will be required for each player seeking scholarship. This money will be returned to the family upon completion of the volunteer hours.

Refund

Refunds, transfers and deferment of scholarship proceeds is not permitted. Returned scholarship funds are rolled over to the next season. The deposit will be refunded upon completion of the volunteer hours or if the scholarship application is withdrawn prior to dates established in the general refund policy.



Scholarship Criteria to be Updated Annually

2009 Fall Season

Deadline: May 30, 2009

Minimum Verification: Completion of application, signed under penalty of perjury

CVYSL fee: Families will write a check for \$19 to cover the CVYSL registration fee. This will be returned to the family once the volunteer hours have been completed or if the application is withdrawn prior to July 1, 2009.

Volunteer requirement: One hour of volunteer time for each \$15 of the scholarship amount. For example, a scholarship of \$70 would require 4 hours of volunteer time. Volunteer time must be completed for each child receiving a scholarship.

Qualification: 200% of the Federal Poverty Level

- Scholarships are accepted through the final registration event on May 30, 2009.
- You will be advised of the amount of your scholarship during the first week of June.
- A \$19 registration fee is requested for each player; this fee will be refunded upon completion of the volunteer hours.
- Family Volunteer hours must match the scholarship funds received for each player. Each volunteer hour equals \$15 of scholarship funds. If a player receives a full registration scholarship of \$70, the family will be expected to complete 4 volunteer hours on behalf of that player.
- Scholarship funds may not be applied toward uniform purchases.

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
